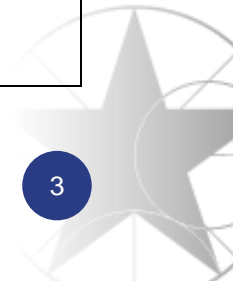


- **Statement of purpose**

Arial Font, 11, about 500 words or 3000 characters



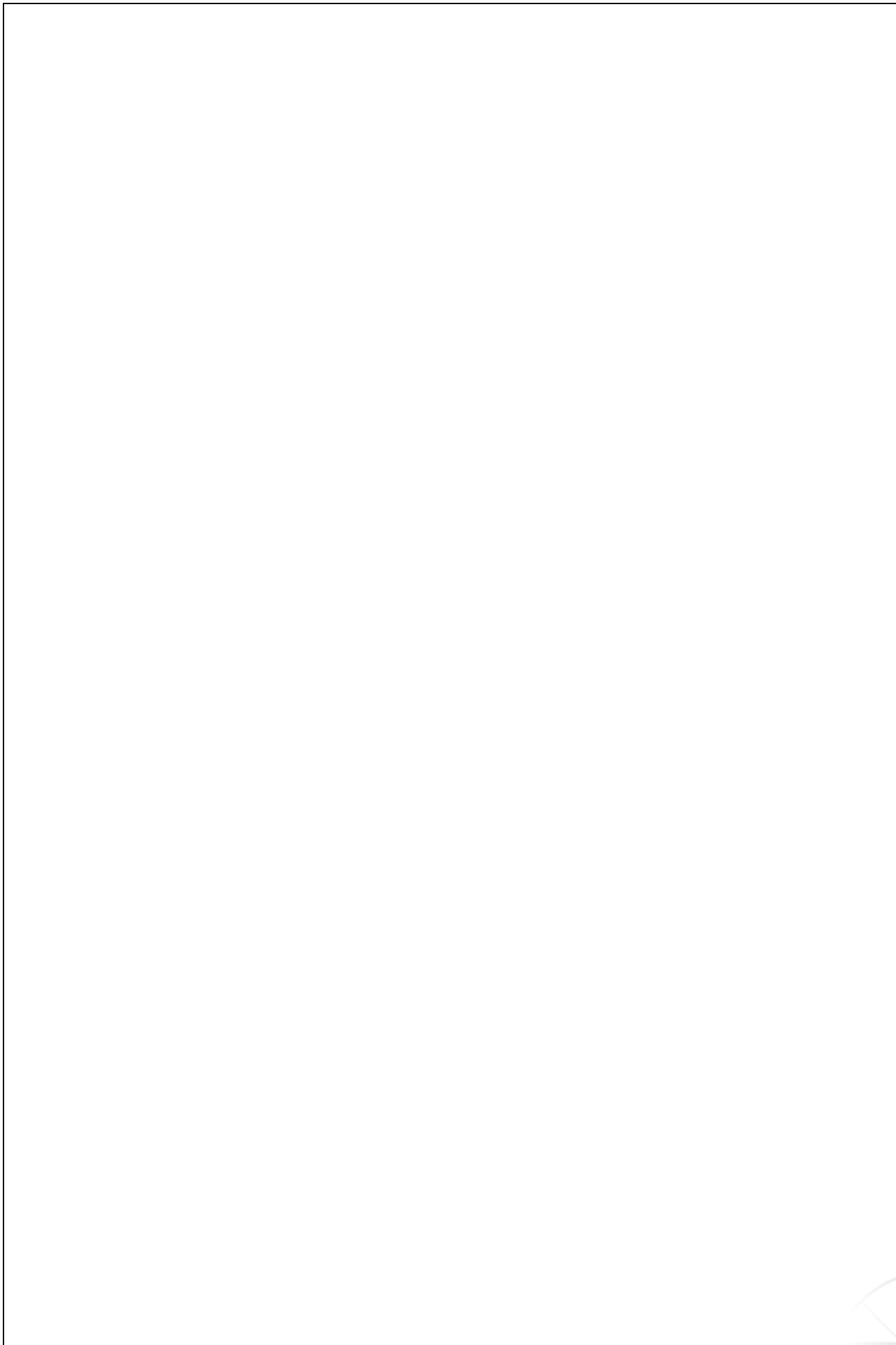
- **Research statement**

One to two pages limit.

The research statement should show us where your interests lie in the field of research and specifically within your subfield. Include any serious research projects which you have engaged in, and what you predict for the future of your research if you join our PhD program.

Arial Font, 11, about 1000 words or 6000 characters

Include contact information of two referees who know you well enough to support your application. We recommend that you consult with potential referees before submitting their names, in order to ensure their contact information is current and that they agree to write positive and informative letters in support of your application.
