



Soon opening: Lecturer / Full Professor position in Analytical Chemistry at Lund University in Sweden

The Faculty of Science at Lund University is looking for a lecturer or full professor who has a strong research profile in analytical chemistry. The successful candidate is expected to establish (or relocate) his/her own research group, within any area of analytical chemistry. The candidate is also expected to be teaching undergraduate and graduate levels courses in analytical chemistry (20-40% teaching duties), especially in chromatographic theory and techniques. A start-up package and relocation support will be given to the candidate.

Department of Chemistry is facing an exciting future, since it will move together with the Department of Physics and Nanoelectronics to a new building in Science Village, which is an area in northeastern Lund that includes the European Spallation Source ESS and Max IV. We are looking for a candidate who can see the potential in building up Analytical Chemistry in the context of Life Science and/or Material Science strategies for research, education, and innovation in Lund Science Village.
